COVID Safety Protocols

Revised July 9, 2022

Our hope is to provide a blessed and safe environment for all of our Congress participants to have a God encounter. As such, during our week together, the following practices will be observed:

VACCINATION

- **All attendees (registered or otherwise) participating in events on The Delaware State University Campus** are required to be fully vaccinated which will be verified prior to entrance into Congress Events.
- All attendees will be required to show physical or digital proof of vaccination status.

COVID TESTING

- **All attendees (registered or otherwise) participating in events on The Delaware State University Campus will be asked to bring proof of a negative COVID test from within 72 hours of arrival.** This may be from an **at home antigen test or a PCR test.** A photo of the negative test is sufficient proof.
- Any person exhibiting symptoms will be provided with an antigen rapid test kit and asked to submit to a COVID test.
- Any persons who test positive for COVID will need to make arrangements to leave the congress immediately. Delaware State has no accommodations for quarantining.

FACE COVERINGS

- Masks will be required to be worn throughout all events. Masks must cover the nose and the mouth.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Physical distancing of at least three feet will be maintained during Congress events.

EMERGENCIES

- If an individual appears in any emergent distress, 911 will be called for the person to seek emergency care.

MEDICATIONS

- No medication will be administered by any health commission member to any attendees with fever or any other COVID-19 related symptoms.
